YEAR FROM THE TIME OF HER DECEASE, FOUR FIFTH
PARTS OF WHICH ARE TO BE APPLIED IN KEEPING
THIS MONUMENT IN GOOD REPAIR AND THE RESIDUE
RETAINED BY THEM FOR THEIR TROUBLE THEREIN**

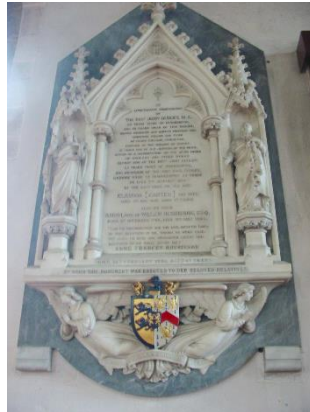
